Ryan's Case for Smiles started with a simple goal: to create and distribute whimsical pillowcases that give children with cancer and other illnesses an emotional boost. Today, our programs have expanded to include the child's entire family to help them cope and avoid the long-term emotional trauma of a child's illness.



Delivery of Pillowcases

Each year, Ryan's Case for Smiles' chapters deliver over 200,000 pillowcases to partner hospitals throughout North America. The chapter coordinators work with their communities to secure the donations, in-kind and financial, needed to create and deliver the whimsical pillowcases. Alongside each pillowcase delivered is an insert card that tells caregivers that they are not alone and directs them to the resources on CopingSpace.org.

CopingSpace.org

Offers valuable, research-informed information for caregivers, schools, and the community surrounding a child with a life-changing illness or injury. There they will find tips and strategies to help their entire family cope with a diagnosis, treatment and recovery, while building resilience for the future.

Coping Boxes

The Coping Boxes are designed to help siblings learn positive coping strategies as well as giving them an outlet for expression. Each box is filled with age-appropriate items siblings can use to help explore and deal with their feelings, as they try to comprehend their brother or sister's illness or injury and treatment. Each item is accompanied by a card that offers ways the item can help reduce stress.

JustSibs.org

An interactive, digital experience to help teens and pre-teens navigate and cope with the many challenges that come with having a sibling with an illness or injury. Through visual storytelling and supportive activities, kids are given a safe space to explore, and learn to manage, a wide variety of feelings that they may face.
